Dr. Shea is Chief, Climate Services Division of the NOAA National Climatic Data Center (NCDC), and since fall of 2005, Director of the NOAA Integrated Data and Environmental Applications Center (NOAA-IDEA). She is responsible for NCDC programs in data access; data integration and visualization; user engagement; education and outreach; and regional, national, and international climate service partnerships. She has written extensively about assessing the consequences of climate variability and change. Her previous academic experiences focused on marine sciences and environmental law.

Dr. Shea is a Fellow of the American Meteorological Society. During her time with NOAA she helped organize the NOAA Climate and Global Change Program and the inter-agency U.S. Global Change Research Program. She served for two years on the Board on Sustainable Development of the U.S. National Research Council and has experience in congressional relations, as well as budget and finance in NOAA. She also has experience with NOAA's Regional Integrated Science and Assessment (RISA) Program focused on societal resilience to environmental change.
